The book only gives the Move Notations (Be5, Nf3, etc) and it does not have even one diagram of a chessboard with pieces to help visually see what he is trying to explain. Unbelievably boring and worthless. To give you an idea of what I am talking about..."The King's Defense starts with d4 Nf6..blah blah..c4 g6 blah blah.... Nc3 Bg7... blah blah". If that sounds like your idea of a fun way to learn something, go for it!
