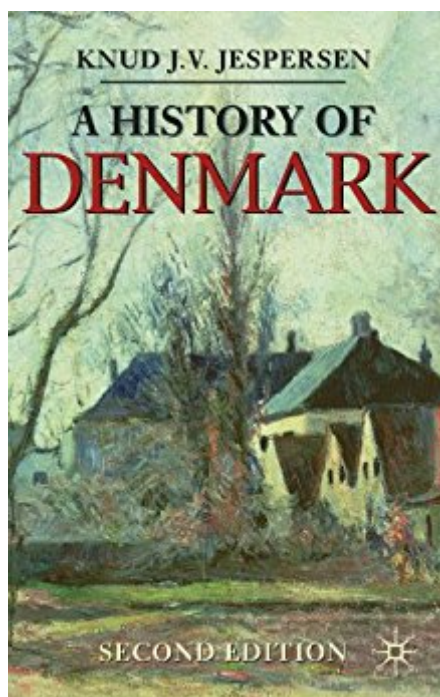


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A History Of Denmark (Palgrave Essential Histories Series)

V. Jespersen traces the process of disintegration and reduction which helped to form the modern Danish state, and the historical roots of Denmark's international position. Beginning with the Reformation in the sixteenth century, Jespersen explains how the Denmark of today was shaped by wars, territorial losses, domestic upheavals, new methods of production, and changes in thought. Thoroughly revised and updated in light of the most recent research, this second edition includes new discussions of the Danish Enlightenment, Denmark's role in World War II, the Cartoon Crisis of 2006 and current NATO debates, bringing the diverse and turbulent history of the country right up to the present day.

As the son of Danes immigrant to the UK in the 1930's, I thought I had a working knowledge of Danish History up to WWII. Surprise! Jespersen's presentation of a series of topics from the XVIth Century through to the beginning of the XXIst puts things together succinctly and clearly. This is an
