

I never tire of hearing them and the entertaining way Garrison Keillor develops the characters and the interlinking narratives. My favorite on this season's stories is "Me and Choir."

I already had a copy of this at home, but I bought this second copy to use at school--primarily the "Letter from Jim" story, which deals with moral dilemmas. Of course, all of the stories are super because of Garrison Keillor's tremendous gift for storytelling. Can't go wrong on this one.

Clarence Bansen has bad (i.e. extremely funny) day, involving static, cramped hand and fear of death, ending with his leaping from a tree to frighten some children and restoring his equilibrium. Only GK could combine all those elements in one of the seasonal CDs from LW. "Me and Choir" is also excellent.
